## 2010 PINEWOOD DERBY

### Almost Anything Goes Division (Adult/Leader Rules)

#### Race-Day/Impound/Car Building Workshop:

Refer to the Cub flyer for dates and times of these events.

#### Impound Rules:

Your car will be weighed and measured. If your car passes inspection, it will be impounded until the time of your race. If your car does not pass inspection, you will be allowed to make the necessary adjustments and be re-inspected that evening or on the morning of the race. Race day inspection will be from 7:30 to 8:00 a.m. At this time your car will be impounded until the time of your race.

#### Standing Rules (Adults/Leaders Only):

- Cars can be made from the standard BSA official Grand Prix Pinewood Derby, by any other means or any combination thereof.
- Added parts must fit within the specified maximum dimensions.

**Weight: 10 oz    Width: 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ "    Length: 7"    Height: 4"**

- If you put weights on the bottom they must be recessed. A minimum of  $\frac{3}{8}$ " clearance is needed to clear the track.
- No loose materials of any kind (lead shot, etc.) are allowed in/on the car. The car may be hollowed and weight added to the allowable limit provided it is securely attached.
- Car must be free wheeling with no starting or propulsion devices.
- The car must start by gravity from a stand still, no pushing or launching devices are permitted.
- Only dry lubricants (i.e. graphite) may be used.
