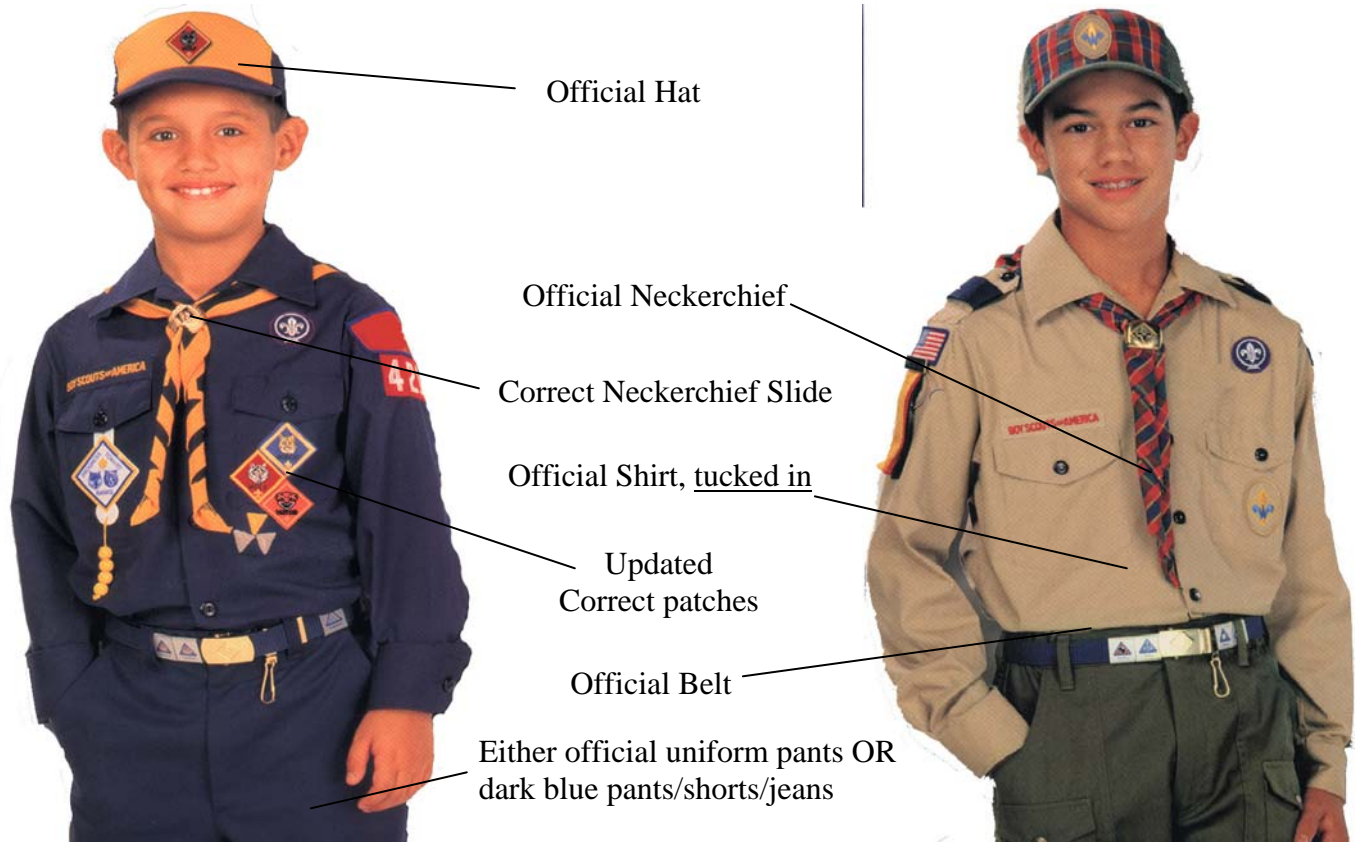


Pack 851 Uniform Guidelines

Each scout should wear:

- Official Hat
- Official Neckerchief
- Correct Neckerchief Slide
- Official Shirt, tucked in
- Updated Correct patches
- Official Belt
- Either official uniform pants OR dark blue pants/shorts/jeans
- Clean, tied shoes—no wheelies!

Class B T-Shirts are acceptable for den meetings, hikes and some other outdoor or messy events.
